4. Andy and Ryan participated in a challenge to collect items for local animal shelters. They collected eight bags of dog food, twenty cans of cat food, three bags of kitty litters, and 1- dog beds. There are three animal shelters in town. If Andy and Ryan give each shelter exactly the same amount of times, how many items will be left over?

5. Juan went to the store with thirty dollars. He spent half of his money on a toy, and then four dollars on a present for his brother. How much money does Juan have left?

6. Kelly was trying to figure out her budget for the month. She spent ten dollars on a movie and five dollars on popcorn. She spent twenty dollars on a new shirt, and twelve dollars on a bracelet. She earned \$50.00 for babysitting her neighbor. How much money does Kelly have left for the month?
